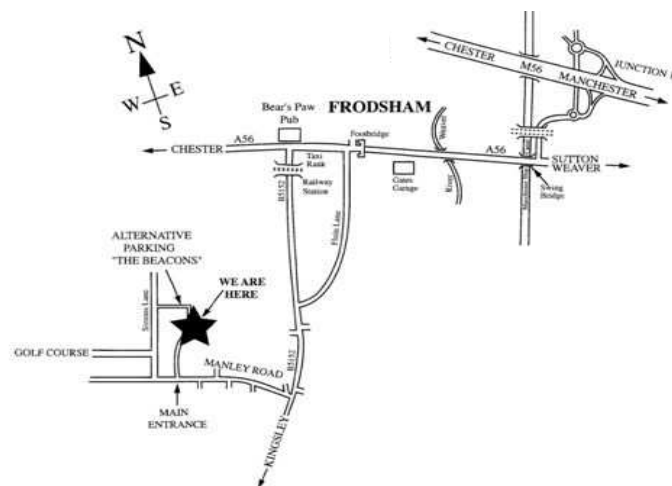

ideal for touring Cheshire and North Wales.

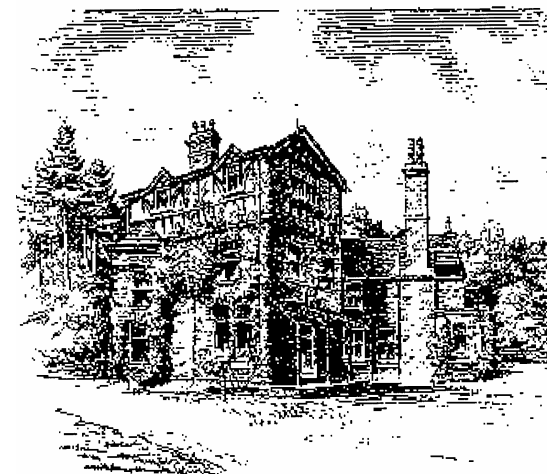


Heathercliffe is one of Cheshire's finest Victo-
